Hello developers, I like this app! This allows me to be able to hear what is playing on my iPad much better! However, I have a question for you: Why is Bluetooth turned on? I went to the settings for my iPad and turned it off a few times. And then turn off my iPad. Every time Bluetooth automatically turns on when I'm powering my iPad. Why? I know assuming not always a smart thing to do, but, I guess if something is set to leave when the iPad is off it should stay off until I turn it back on. My annoyance is that with Bluetooth on all the time running the iPad battery down is very fast! Please help me understand why this is happening. Here we demonstrate a firmware update on the JBL Flip 3 Bluetooth speaker. The process can take fifteen to twenty minutes depending on the speed of the Wi-Fi Internet connection, the source of the device used to update the speaker, the distance between the speaker and the original mobile device, and so on. Also, the update is irreversible once done. That is, you won't be able to go back to the previous version of the firmware after completing this update. So, make sure you really want an update and have reviewed all of its implications before you go ahead with installing a new firmware. Preparing for a firmware update on JBL Flip 3 you'll need the following elements: broadband Internet connection, Bluetooth enabled mobile or desktop device, JBL Connect Plus (Connect) app that runs on the said mobile device, JBL Flip 3 speaker you're updating, Compatible USB power adapters and charging cables for speakers and mobile devices. So connect your mobile device to the Internet and install the Connect app if you haven't already. Then connect JBL Flip 3 to ac-power. Why? Because we don't want his battery to die during the upgrade. A fading battery can leave a damaged version of the firmware in the memory speaker, and a brick speaker, making it useless and unused. Do the same for your mobile device as well, for the same reason. Connect the device and speaker to the AC power. Be sure to unpair any other bluetooth speakers from your mobile device during this firmware update process. Then, power the speaker and mobile device, if not yet powered ON. Then connect the mobile device with the bluetooth speaker JBL Flip 3. Now you're ready to start updating the firmware on this wireless speaker. Update firmware on JBL Flip 3 Bluetooth speaker as 1. Connect JBL Flip 3 to AC Power, if it's not already done, we plugged our JBL Flip 3 to the AC socket using the USB power adapter that we got in another JBL speaker, as well as the cable we got with that speaker. Watch this on Shot. The JBL Flip 3 Bluetooth speaker, connected to AC power. 2. Find the JBL Connect app on your mobile device that we found on the fourth home page in our Apple iPad Air, as shown below. The iOS Home Screen showing the JBL Connect app is highlighted. 3. JBL JBL launch (JBL Connect Plus) The app to continue the firmware update on the JBL Flip 3 app takes a few seconds to find Flip 3. During this time, it shows you some pretty animations when you first start it. But in the end, it finds your paired JBL Flip 3 Bluetooth speaker and displays its screen status as it goes on. If the speaker doesn't show up in the app in thirty seconds or so, move it closer to your mobile device, close the Connect Plus app and run it again. Notice the white point of explanation inside the orange circle in the upper right corner of the speaker image, as indicated by the blue arrow. The firmware update then begins, with the download of the firmware update file from the Internet, via the mobile device, to the speaker via a Bluetooth connection, as shown in the following screenshots. The JBL Connect Plus app on iOS is connected to the JBL Flip 3 Bluetooth speaker. The display of the firmware update page as a new firmware file is copied from mobile device to speaker. 5a. A firmware update starts copying a file from the Internet to a speaker is the slowest part of the firmware update process. But as shown in these screenshots, the JBL Connect app shows you the progress of the pie-chart picture, which gradually becomes more orange as the IOSing transfer of files continues. The JBL Connect Plus app on iOS is paired with the JBL Flip 3 speaker. Transfer the firmware file to this speaker, 40 percent done. 5b. The pie scheme is now completely orange. JBL Connect Plus app on iOS, paired with the portable JBL Flip 3 speaker. Transferring a new firmware update file to this speaker is 100 percent done. Once the app copies the update file on JBL Flip 3, you get the Successful Update screen, as shown below. However, note that the speaker is still in the process of installing a new firmware for about half a minute after you first see this green and white screen. Thus, this screen warns us that our speaker will restart automatically, and it asks us not to turn off the speaker during its upgrade launch. The JBL Connect Plus app on iOS is paired with the JBL Flip 3 bluetooth speaker and the power bank. The new firmware update for the speaker is a success. Made the button highlighted. 6. Wait until JBL Flip 3 turn off to watch the power light on the speaker as shown further. Eventually it will go dark, as shown the next, pointed to the green arrow. If, like ours, your not returned after the firmware update, then go ahead with the next step (Step 7). But if your did go back online though, then skip Step 7 and pick up with step 8. 7. Power on JBL Flip 3 continue to update the firmware on the JBL Flip 3 Press dark energy button to enable this Bluetooth speaker again. It should be paired again with your mobile device where you work the JBL Connect Plus app. The power button becomes solid blue with the speaker successfully paired again with the tablet or phone, as shown further. JBL Flip 3 battery bluetooth speaker, showing its power button glowing blue. 8. Tap the Green Done button in the Connect app with a speaker that successfully is spiced up with the JBL Connect app, click the green Made button, as shown in the last screenshot. The app then displays the JBL Flip 3 status screen again. However, this time, note that there is no more orange circling point explanation (!), as shown further.
